

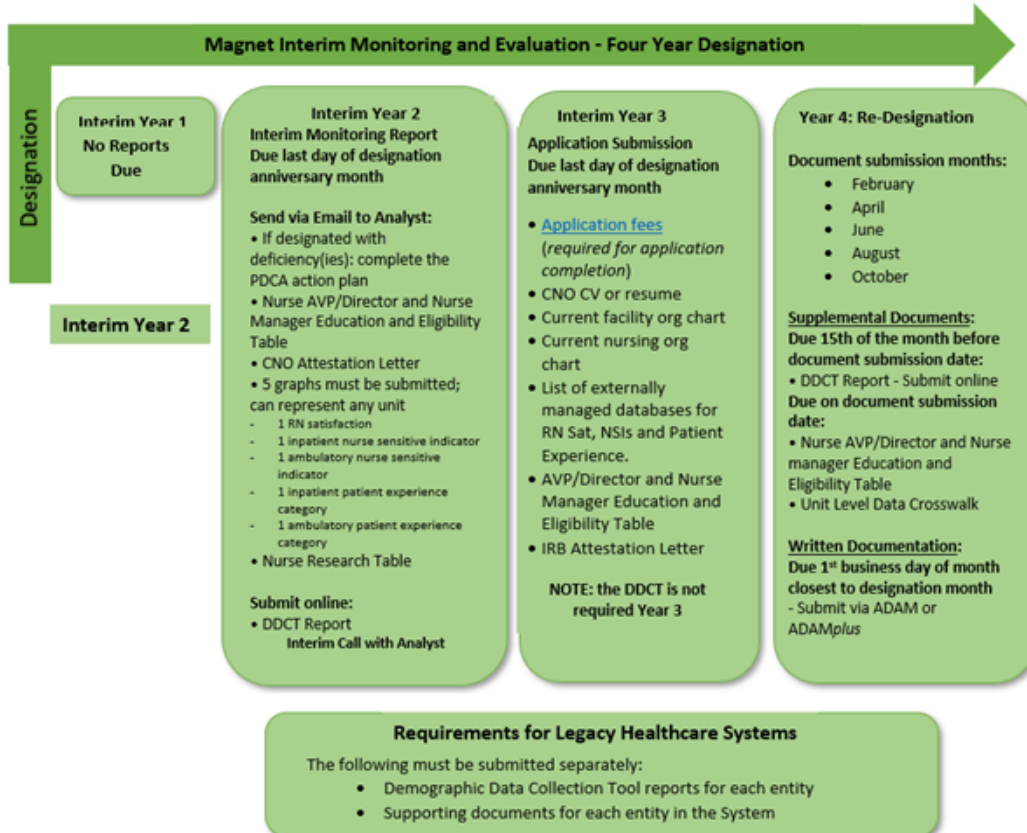

specialized facility: For Magnet purposes, a specialized facility provides long-term, inpatient care; for example, psychiatric, rehabilitation, and skilled nursing facilities (SNF). These settings differ from specialty organizations. (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, 2024a) See specialty organization
specialty organization: Organizations that are primarily or exclusively engaged in the care and treatment of specific conditions or populations, e.g. cardiac, orthopedic, surgical procedures, pediatric. (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, 2024b)

Page 205: Under "turnover rate" replace the final sentence in the definition with: "Staff who are not employed by the organization, such as supplemental agency and travelers, are not included."
